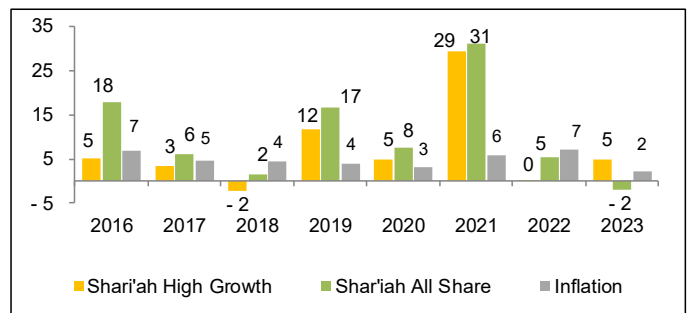
About the portfolio

A Shari'ah compliant portfolio is designed to grow an investor's savings over the long term (six years or more). This portfolio is invested in both local and international types of investments that are Shari'ah compliant, such as shares, sukuk and listed property. Investment managers who are specialists in a particular asset class are appointed to invest assets within their area of expertise. This portfolio has a low chance of the value of one's investment going down over the long term. The value of your investment will go up and down in the short term due to the exclusions required by Islamic law. This means that there are fewer shares and other types of assets available to invest in, which may result in the portfolio being more volatile over the short term.
